#### **B.** Building Fund Pledge

The Building Fund is a mandatory pledge each new member family makes to support the synagogue for the future. It is a critical part of our financial well-being and is used to repair pipes, replace air conditioning, clean carpeting, maintain the overall health of the building, and provide contingency funds for unexpected building related expenses. This is not an optional fee and the amount paid will not be applied towards the Building Fund until your membership dues pledge has been paid for the year.
